The focus of this trip will be on building relationships of trust and giving the Lummi people the opportunity to see God demonstrated in the lives of others. Our team will work on home repairs, painting projects, and general neighborhood cleanup. In addition, there is opportunity to be involved with VBS at various apartment complexes, sports outreach, home visitation, youth and adult Bible study/mentoring, as well as ministry to seniors through crafts and music. This is a great opportunity to serve as an entire family, learn about tribal life, and build bridges among our neighbors.

LOGISTICS

The team will sleep and eat at the Veterans Building located on the Lummi reservation throughout our entire stay. You will need to bring your own sleeping bags and air mattresses for sleeping on the floor.

Learning:

Our desire is for this trip to be truly a learning opportunity for you and your children. One of the highlights will definitely be getting to interact with the local culture up close!

Outreach:

PREPARATION

"I've never joined a mission trip before. I have no idea what to expect. We recognize that joining a mission trip can feel a little intimidating! Let us put your mind at ease, we are committed to help train and equip you for this experience. You don't need any special qualifications, other than to show up and love people. However, in order for you to get the most out of your experience, the following are some requests we will ask of you.

Training Meetings: There will be around 6 training meetings that we expect all team members to commit to attend. These are vitally important to your preparation and the preparation of the team!

Prayer Team: We ask that every team member build a prayer team of around 5-7 people who will commit to pray for you and the team.

Financial Team: We do not expect for you to pay for your trip all on your own, but we invite you to seek financial partnerships with family and friends. We will train you on how to do this.

Perspective: Lastly we ask all team members to come in as a learner and seek to humbly serve. We desire that you be willing to open your heart to be able to hear and respond to God's work in your life. Keep in mind, the most important thing may not be the trip itself, but how God wants you to live as a <u>result</u> of your experience.
