Our local hosts Luis, Grisel, Victor, and Janet are known for inviting visitors into their homes and treating them as honored guests. Be prepared to be welcomed as part of their family the moment your feet hit the ground on this beautiful island. The Puerto Rico mission trip will give you and the entire team an opportunity to experience a rich culture and serve among a people with a great passion for the Lord.
