



PERU MEDICAL MISSION

Join this dynamic team to venture to the city of Tacna, located at the southwestern tip of Peru, in the desert region just 22 miles from the Chilean border. Here we will come alongside our partner, IAM www.iamweb.org who are doing meaningful ministry there. There are three growing churches in Tacna, with diverse social projects that include children's feeding programs, park ministry, medical programs as well as vibrant children and youth ministry. During this trip we will help address some of the medical needs in the community. Healthcare in this area is very unreliable and expensive for the local people. The churches in the area believe that it is their calling to bring health to their communities and thousands have benefited from visiting medical teams in the past. They already have a medical clinic in place, with missionaries that are planning to come run it in late 2019 or early 2020. There are plenty of unique medical opportunities available here to serve the community depending on the skill set of the team.

MEDICAL MINISTRY: The team we will help offer general health screenings (including medicines and minor procedures) in several locations throughout the city. **We are seeking doctors, nurses, physical therapists, chiropractors, dermatologists, dentists, optometrists, nutritionists among more.**

ESTIMATED COST: \$2,400* (\$900 + Airfare)
