



**PERU MEDICAL MISSION
November 2-11, 2019**

Join this dynamic team as they venture to the city of Tacna, located at the southwestern tip of Peru, in the desert region just 22 miles from the Chilean border. Here we will come alongside our partner, IAM www.iamweb.org, who are doing some amazing ministry in this city. There are three growing churches in Tacna who have a vision to bless their community with ongoing, quality, and affordable healthcare. Healthcare in their area is unreliable and expensive, therefore many medical needs go unmet. In early 2020, they plan to open a permanent health clinic, but in the meantime could use a team to help catalyze this vision by offering general health screenings & check-ups in several locations throughout the city. A medical team from Overlake came last year and had a tremendous impact on the churches and community. Some wonderful relationships were formed as well and we look forward to continuing to nurture those friendships.

MEDICAL MINISTRY: The team will help offer general health screenings, check-ups, medicines and minor procedures (ex. wart/mole removal) in several locations throughout the city. The clinic will be open for all ages. **We are seeking doctors, pediatricians, nurses, physical therapists, dermatologists, chiropractors, pharmacists, optometrists, and dentists** just to name a few. Let us know your expertise and I am sure we can put you to work!

ESTIMATED COST: \$2,400* (\$900 + Airfare)

Payment Schedule: July 1st - \$200 Deposit Due, Aug. 1st - \$1,400 Due, Oct. 1st - Final Balance Due
